

Photography And Filming Policy

Purpose

This policy outlines the guidelines for photography and videography, during **MC Kickboxing & Fitness UK** Classes, Workshops and Events, ensuring the safety, privacy and respect of all participants.

Consent

-All members and participants must provide consent before being photographed or filmed.

For

minors, consent must be obtained from a parent or guardian.

- A consent form should be distributed and collected prior to any photography or videography taking place.

Responsible Usage

Photos and videos should only be used for club related purposes, such as promoting activities, showcasing achievements, or educational use. All content must reflect the values and sportsmanship of **MC Kickboxing & Fitness UK** .

Privacy & Dignity

Participants should be encouraged to speak up if they feel uncomfortable or wish to opt out of being photographed or filmed. Avoid capturing images or videos that may embarrass or invade the privacy of individuals

Respect & Sensitivity

Respect the opinions of individuals regarding their participation in photography or videography. If someone refuses to be photographed or filmed, their wishes must be honoured. Be aware of cultural sensitivities regarding photography and videography.

Copyright & Distribution

Ensure that all photography and videography is done in compliance with copyright laws. Only share images / videos that you have permission to use.

Before posting any images or videos to social media or club communication channels, ensure approval has been obtained from those depicted.
